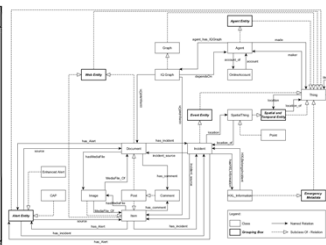
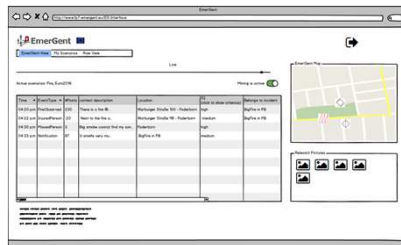
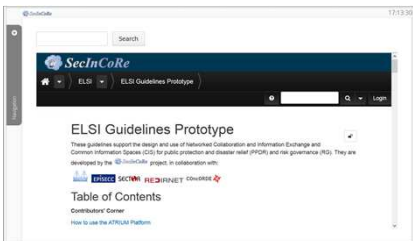
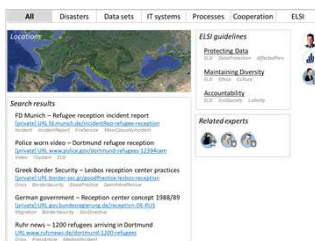
- Adopt requirements and ELSI constraints
